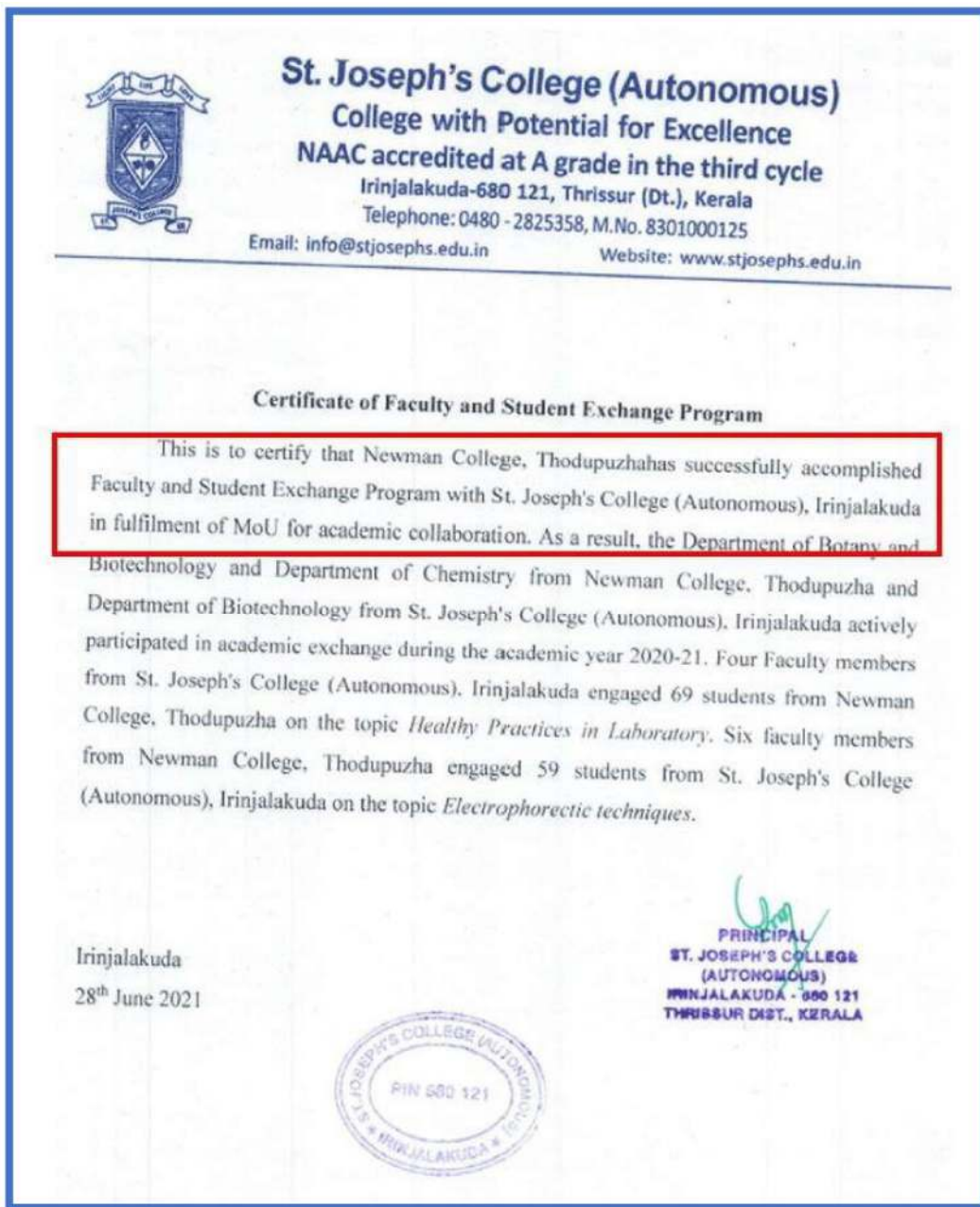

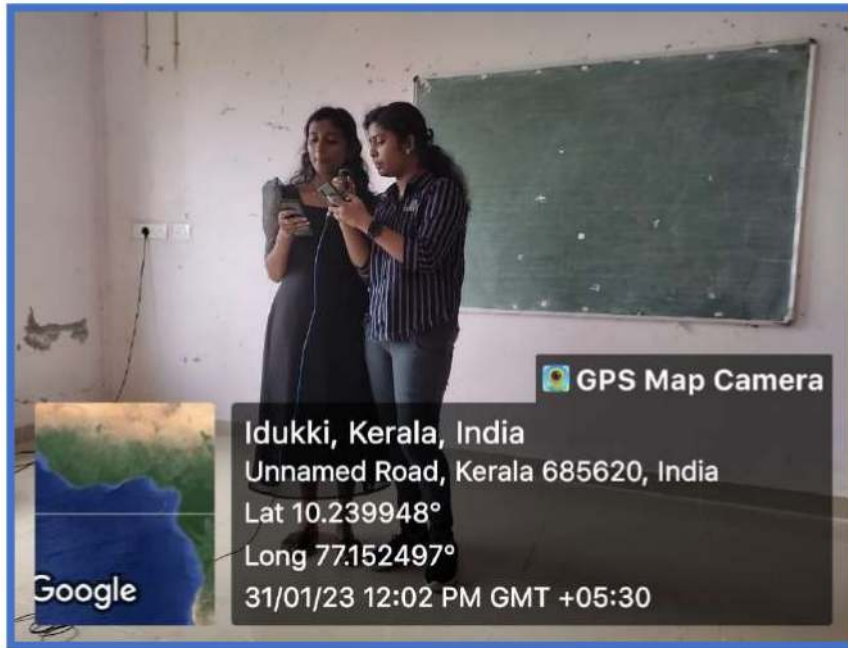

SARS-Coronavirus 2, A Metabolic Reprogrammer: A Review in the Context of the Possible Therapeutic Strategies

Abstract: Novel coronavirus, SARS-CoV-2, is advancing at a staggering pace to devastate the health care system and foster concerns over public health. In contrast to the past outbreaks, coronaviruses are not clinging themselves as a strict respiratory virus. Rather, becoming a multifaceted virus, it affects multiple organs by interrupting a number of metabolic pathways leading to significant rates of morbidity and mortality. Following infection, they rigorously reprogram multiple metabolic pathways of glucose, lipid, protein, nucleic acid, and their metabolites to extract adequate energy and carbon skeletons required for their existence and further molecular constructions inside a host cell. Although the mechanism of these alterations is yet to be known, the impact of these reprogramming is reflected in the hyperinflammatory responses, so called cytokine storm and the hindrance of the host immune defence system. The metabolic reprogramming during SARS-CoV-2 infection needs to be considered while devising therapeutic strategies to combat the disease and its further complication. The inhibitors of cholesterol and phospholipids synthesis and cell membrane lipid raft of the host cell can, to a great extent, control the viral load and further infection. Depletion of energy sources by inhibiting the activation of glycolytic and hexosamine biosynthetic pathways can also augment antiviral therapy. Thodupuzha municipality referred to as TM, of the SECOND PART, for the purpose of exchange of professional, academic guidance and services in the field of waste management and sustainable development.

Preamble

WHEREAS, NMC and TM have common interest in the areas of waste management and sustainable development, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of disposal and processing of waste; maintenance of sustainable ecosystem and social commitment.

NOW THEREFORE, NMC and TM have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two parties set out in the following sections.

Objective:

Both parties agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the areas of mutual interest:

- a. Provide professional assistance or services for waste disposal and processing and green ecosystems initiatives.
- b. Provide professional assistance and services for awareness activities related to waste management and sustainable developmental goals.

PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

NMC and TM propose to collaborate through

- a. NMC will take internal measures to segregate waste according to its type and keep the college campus a conducive environment for students and other stakeholders
- b. TM will provide assistance in collection and disposal of waste from NMC
- c. NMC will provide the services/ professional expertise of the student and teacher volunteers for attaining various sustainable development goals of mutual interest.
- d. NMC will provide its physical infrastructure for awareness programmes and events conducted by TM for the students of NMC and general public with mutual consultation and based on availability.

Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of Five years commencing from effective date. Parties may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review. Either party may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of one month in advance to the other.

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both NMC and TM. Participating faculties, staff and students involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the law of the host countries and rules and regulations of the institutions. Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

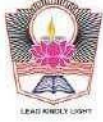
