Dr. Bejoy Thomas studied chemistry at the University of Bangalore (India) and received his PhD in physical chemistry from Cochin University of Science and Technology (India). After working for some time in NMR spectroscopy at the Indian Institute of Science (India), he moved to Germany as a DFG (German Chemical Society) postdoctoral fellow at the Institute of Chemical Technology, University of Stuttgart. Dr. Bejoy then moved to France as a CNRS postdoctoral associate at the Laboratoire de Chimie de la Matière de Condensée de Paris, UPMC-PS before coming back to India to join Newman College, Thodupuzha, Kerala in 2011. The focus of his work is self-assembly of biosurfactant molecules including long chain fatty acids and their esters, small proteins, polysaccharides, etc. synthesis of hierarchical zeolites, ordered mesoporous materials, surface science, and catalysis, and in situ NMR spectroscopy of working catalysts. Recently, the work is focussed on the extraction, characteristics, and application of nanocellulosic materials, especially towards catalysis. Dr. Bejoy has an h-index of 21 and published about 40 research articles in high impact journals.

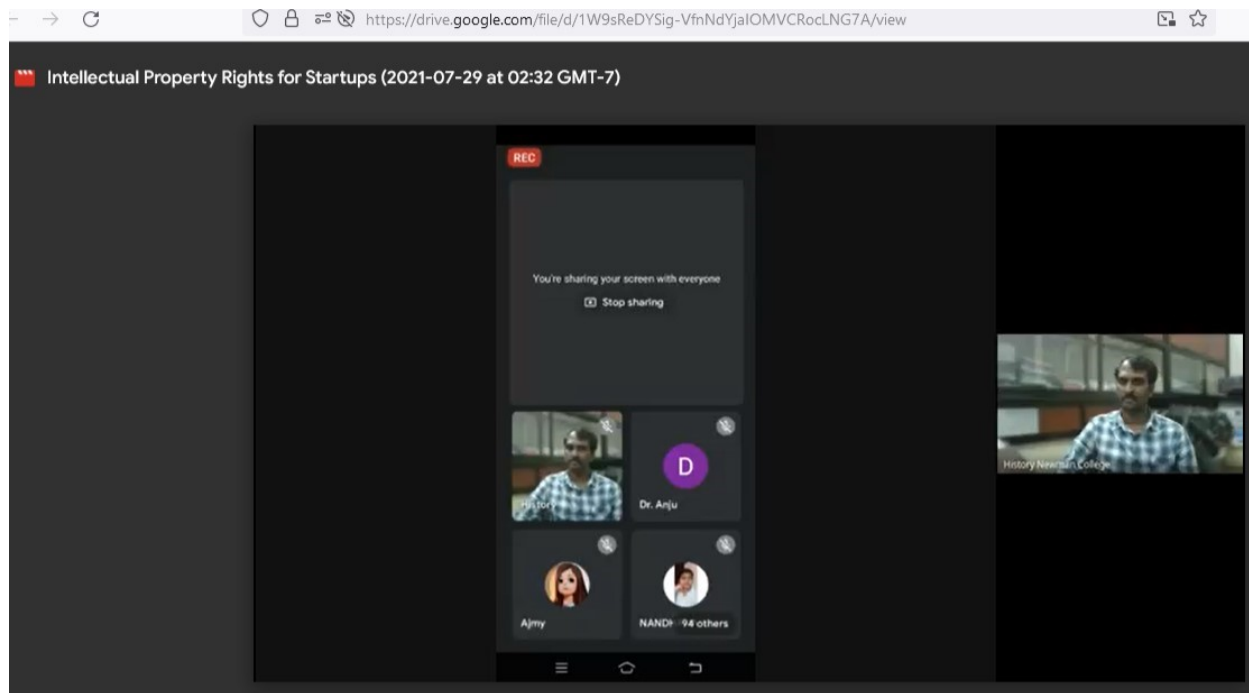
ABOUT THE SPEAKER

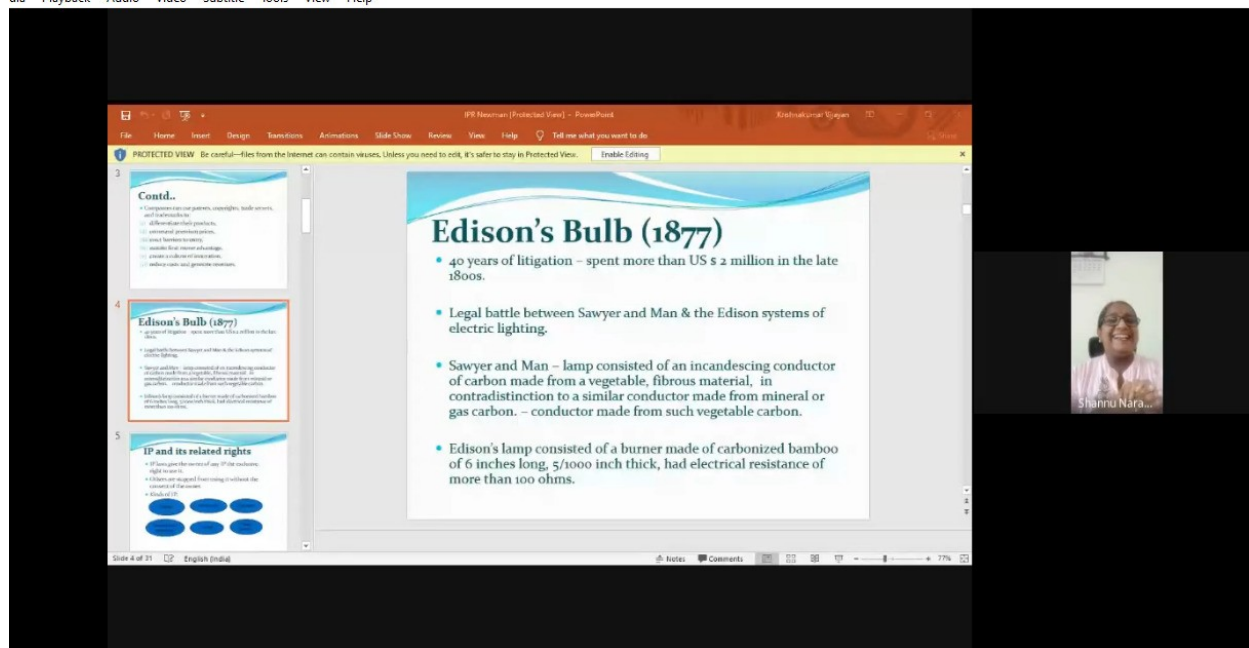

About the webinar
Hydroponics, a water-smart solution, has become popular in developed countries to grow pesticide-free produce on rooftops and terraces. India's hydroponics market is expected to grow at a compound annual growth rate of 13.53% in the coming years. The talk is organized to create awareness among young people about the scope of hydroponics, motivating them to launch new start ups.

About the speaker

 Dr. Sunnichan V George obtained his Bachelor's and Master's degrees with gold medals. He is the recipient of prestigious fellowships such as JRF from Ministry of Environment and Forest, ICAR, and SRF from CSIR-UGC. He did his doctoral degree from University of Delhi in Crop genetics and Breeding in 1999 and post doctoral degree from ICGEB (International Centre For Genetic engineering and Biotechnology), New Delhi, India.

He was the research scientist in the UN organization in generating transgenic cotton plants using Bt genes and succeeded in developing new cotton transgenics through a high frequency plant regeneration method. He has got DST young scientist award for the same work. He has around 25 years of research experience in plant biotechnology and molecular farming of vegetables, fruits and other field crops, and various other fields related to horticulture including tissue culture. He earned advanced specialist programs in horticulture and agricultural biotechnology from University of Colorado, USA and had been working as Assistant professor of Biology, at St. Thomas University Miami, USA for a decade. He was the former director of Research, Homegrown Nursery and Farms, Kanjirappally. There, his contributions towards the multiplication and genetic enhancement of exotic fruit crops namely, Rambutan, Pulasan, Mangosteen etc. and the import of various varieties of these items from Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, USA etc. was admirable. He wrote many articles related to fruit crops cultivation in Malayalam agriculture magazines like Malayala Manorama Karshakasree, Deepika Karshakan and several Malayalam and English dailies. He is the founder and CEO of two new start ups in soil less system for ornamental plants and manufacturing of biofertilizers, biopesticides etc.

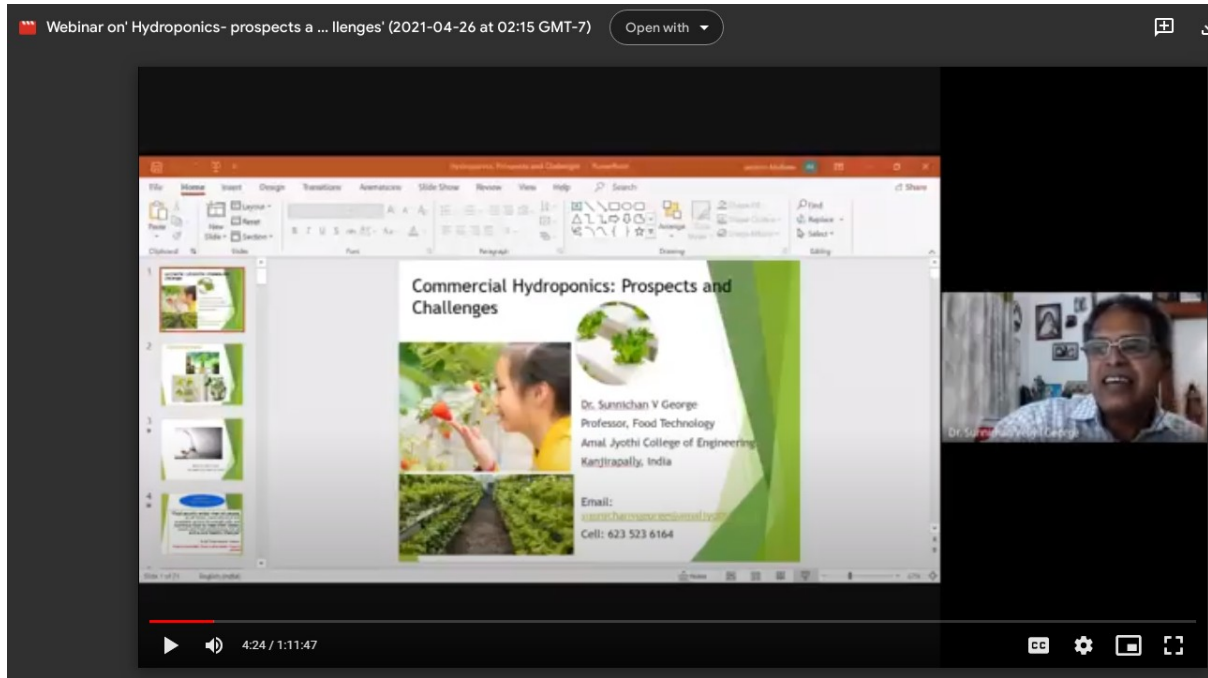

Data Processing: To format XL worksheet for data entry - To import the data into Excel - To clean the data entered/imported - To check data to find the errors - To find and delete duplicate entries in the same worksheet - To crosscheck two worksheets/data sources to find duplicate entries - To filter data using specified conditions - To auto fill numbers, date, formula, text patterns etc. - To put the given text into different columns - To create data entry forms to ease the data entry process - To validate data cells by giving conditions for better accuracy in data entry - To sort the data using conditions based on value, icon, font colour, cell colour etc. - To auto highlight the data/data cells based on the given conditions by showing (a) that text/font in the colour specified (b) those cells in solid/gradient colours or (c) an extra icon with the data in the cell - To interchange columns and rows without affecting data - To create Google Form and bringing the collected data into Excel - To use different functional formulas (AND, IF, IFS, OR, IF(OR, IF(AND, DATEDIF, LOOKUP, CONCAT) - To protect the data from unauthorised access.

Mathematical Analysis: To do the basic calculations including percentage, power, square root etc.- To count and to calculate the sum, average, maximum and minimum values without formula - To do calculations based on absolute, relative and partial references - To set auto calculations based on date, time and duration to find out depreciation, wages etc. - To convert the unit of measurements from one to another - To assign ranks so as to change it automatically - To prepare the summarised Cross Tabulation Sheets from row data - To link the summarised cross table and chart with the raw data table so as to update automatically according to the changes - To prepare the Summary Reports/Tables based on data from different worksheets - To use Slicers to create more informative reports.

Statistical Analysis: To use MS excel for Simple random sampling and Stratified random sampling – To prepare discrete and continuous frequency tables - To calculate the Measures of Central Tendency (Mean, Median, Mode, HM, GM) and Measures of Dispersion (Range, Percentiles, S.D., Variance), Moving averages, Skewness and Kurtosis, Trend analysis, Correlation and Regression analysis etc. - To perform hypothesis tests such as Z Test, t Test, F Test, X2 Test etc. using MS Excel.

Financial Analysis: To generate summary reports for managerial decisions - To calculate PV, FV, NPV, IRR etc. for financial decisions - To use MS Excel to analyse and interpret the financial performance more effectively.



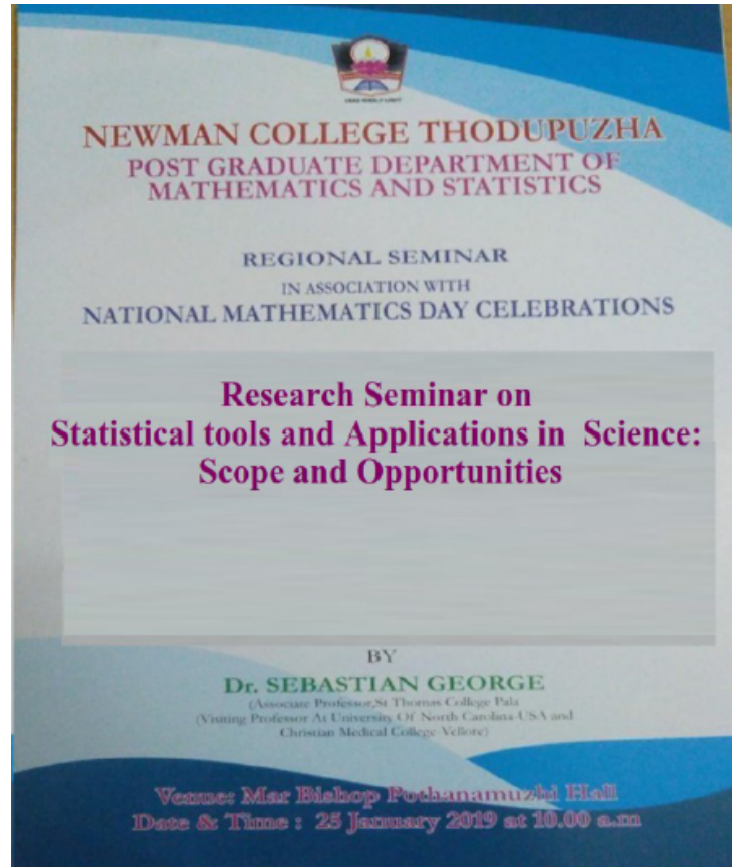

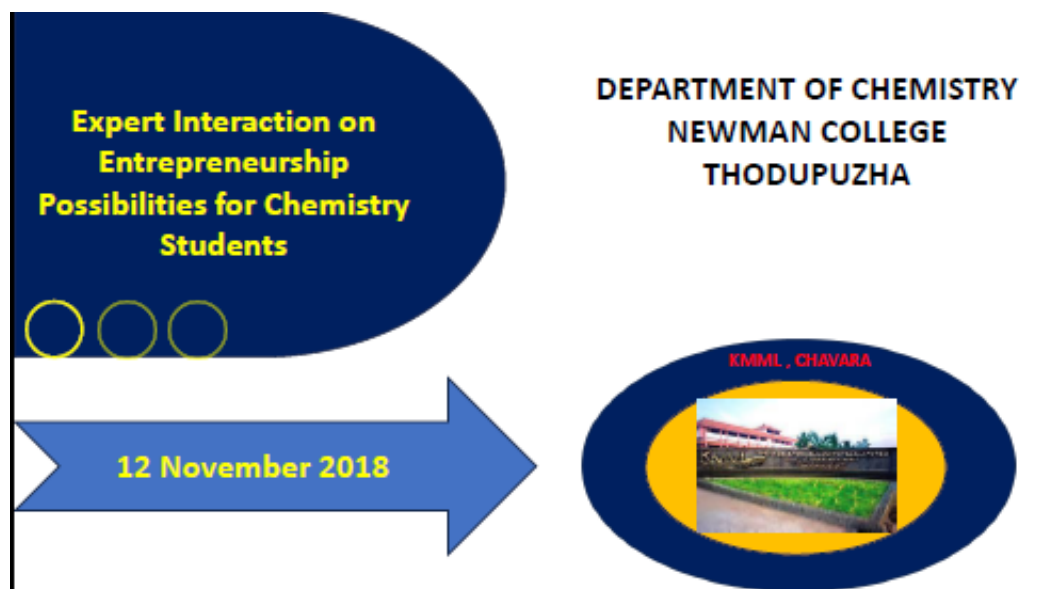
