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I. INTRODUCTION

We have experienced this year as a tremendous one as the college registered its position at top level in both academic and non-academic realms in M.G. University. I am proud to tell you that the college has secured twenty-two university ranks including two first ranks in the M. G. University U.G and P.G. Examinations. Kumari Leena James of English Department won First rank in M.A. English Examination and Kum. Akhila G. of Economics Department also secured First rank in M. A. Economics Examination. The students of other departments also widened the fame of the college by securing formidable positions in the top ten tally of M.G. University examinations. We see this as a great achievement in the history of our college. The College displayed unparalleled performance in the M. G. University Youth Festival also. A surprise performance by Newman College Thodpuzha captivated art lovers as well as academic community in the M.G. University arts festival, Alathalam 2019. Newman College secured Fifth position in the meet with 48 points just behind the former champions Maharaja's College Ernakulam. Newman College leaves behind all other colleges in Kottayam and Idukki districts and clinches the fifth place with only the usual festival favourites from Ernakulam district leading ahead of it. The College also shares the first position in the literary events with the Champions S. H College, Thevara. This is the best performance by the college in the history of M.G arts fest and turns to be a historic achievement. Newman College opened the point tally with the first position in Thiruvathira and continued the spirit in Margam kali and Oppana by bagging second position in both. Reximol Mathew and Krishnanunni B secured first position in Malayalam Elocution and English Short Story Writing respectively. A team consisting Ashkar Ali, Abin Jolly and Sidharth Vylopilly secures top position in Quiz competition. Meera Rajesh, J Ganesh Ram, Romis P. Tom, Srelakshmi A.S, and J Ganesh Ram won third prize in various competitions. Iris Abraham, a first year M. Com. Students surprisingly finished in third position in the male dominated event Mimicry. The achievement is a result of a joint effort by students and teachers, of our college.

Departments of English, Mathematics, Chemistry, Zoology, Economics and History concluded their Golden Jubilee celebrations this year with various finely tuned programmes with

the participation of the academic and public community around Thodpuzha. The college proudly heralds the completion of two great infrastructural developments in this year. XX. FUTURE PLANS

Having reaccredited at ‘A’ grade by the NAAC with a relatively high score of 3.32 out of 4, the college is all set to enter the next phases of its growth, namely the Centre with Potential for Excellence (CPE) status and autonomous status. If the extent of commitment and team spirit displayed by the staff and students during the re-accreditation process is any indication, these goals are not distant dreams. The college is marching ahead in that direction. The other future plans include:

1. Expansion of Entrance

Alteration and modification of gateway to the college is one of the priorities to be done in the near future. We plan to modify it by expanding the vehicle runway and pedestrian's path. As the Govt. of Kerala have issued an order No. 26433/G1/15/H.Edn. dt. 12-10-2015 which clearly stipulates designated parking area for students' vehicles, the parking area is proposed to be developed at the right side of the proposed gate. The Expansion of Teacher's parking area is also expected to be completed

2. New Block Using RUSA Fund

RUSA government agency has allotted 2 crores for infrastructure development and renovation. The college has decided to build a new academic block connecting the existing office block with the commerce department.

4. Women's Studies Centre

College is looking forward to starting a Women's Studies centre with the financial support UGC. We hope that this centre will be an important step in various academic activities.

5. Auditorium Renovation

We have decided to make necessary alterations to the college auditorium to make it sound proof. We also intend to expand the stage and furnish it properly to facilitate the staging of various programmes.

6. Office Block Modification

The Expansion of the Office block is a necessary thing to be done. We would like to extend the room provided for IQAC cell, along with a computerised office system, Exam monitoring section and an additional seminar Hall.

7. Research Centre

The departments of English, Physics, and Chemistry are approved research centres of Mahatma Gandhi University. The College plans to facilitate the research activities by setting up research centres which can function as academic spaces for research scholars and the research activities.

9. Open Stage and Art Gallery

The College is a centre of many cultural/literal/theatrical activities. The present infrastructure is not enough to conduct all the cultural events. So we are planning to build an open stage to enhance these activities. The college also plans to set up an art gallery for students/teachers who can draw, paint and sculpture.
